



## 2019 Korean Harvest Festival Snack Vendor Application

**Location:** North York Mel Lastman Square | 5100 Yonge St, North York, ON M2N 5V7

**Set Up Date:** Friday August 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2019 12:00pm – 5:00 pm

**Festival Dates:** Saturday August 24th, 2019 – Sunday August 25th, 2019 10:00 am – 10:00 pm

The annual Korean Harvest Festival will be held this year at Mel Lastman Square. The festival will serve as the main gateway to the people of Toronto interested in Korean culture and the Korean community. Many vendors and performers will participate this year to show the +35,000 attendees ‘a taste of Korea’ to Toronto. The 2019 festival will run from Saturday August 24 to Sunday August 25, 2019. You will have five hours to set up your booth for operation over the weekend on Friday August 23<sup>rd</sup>, **no sales are permitted**. The following document will serve as an agreement between the booth operator or representative and the KCBA, the host of the festival.

### Please Note

- Maximum of 2 Booths can be applied under one business/organization/applicant
- Vendors must be present for **all** days of the rented dates during the festival. If the vendor is not present during or before final the rented dates, the Korean Harvest Festival reserves the right to remove/relocate/substitute the vendor’s assigned booth.
- Availability and placement of booths is a first-come first-serve basis and with agreement with the 2019 Korean Harvest Festival Food Booth Operation Team.
- The Korean Harvest Festival may place your booth according to festival themes and location standards depending on the booth merchandise, theme, type of business.
- Please refer below to the “Booth Rental Table” for the full list booth type and rental explanation
- Payments are payable via cheque, bank draft and/or money orders or cash.
- **Booth placement is reserved when full payment has been made and processed.**

All items the vendor shall sell and display at the event will be the items listed above and must be accepted by the Market Booth Coordinator. No other products may be displayed, sold or be given out at the event by the vendor. The products or services of the vendor may not conflict with the products or services of a sponsor with exclusivity rights at the event.

Payment of a 50% deposit for rental fees shall be due within two weeks of signing this application and contract. Balance of rental fees will be guaranteed via post-dated cheque by August 1, 2019. If payment is not sent the reserved spot will be withdrawn. All payments must be remitted in Canadian funds by a bank draft, money order, or cheque made payable to: KCBA, Korean Canadian Business Association

If a cancellation is made before 08/01, 2019 – 80% of the deposit will be refunded / Cancellation after 08/01, 2019 – No refunds

## **IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ Food/Snack Vendor Rules & Regulations:**

- 1. Snack Prices.** All menu items must cost less than \$7 to be considered a snack.
- 2. Food Variety Control.** Up to two food vendors can sell the same/similar item at the festival. Korean Harvest Festival staff will notify vendors if some food items cannot be served at the festival.
- 3. Number of Food Items Per Booth.** Vendors are allowed to sell a maximum of 5 types of food items per booth purchased.
- 4. Food Containers.** Although there are tables and chairs available, we encourage food vendors to consider serving their food in a way that allows people to easily eat while standing or sitting, with one or two hands.
- 5. Food handling certification.** All vendor staff must have a valid food handler certification available for inspection. Vendor staff will have access to hand washing station.
- 6. Beverages.** Vendors may sell bottled, canned, or juice-boxed, non-alcoholic beverages (pop, water, juice) at their booths. Simple beverages do not count against the 5 food item maximum limit. Complex beverages like smoothies and bubble teas count towards the limit.

### **Other Important Rules:**

- 7. Hours of Operation.** Set Up will be on Friday August 23 2019 from 12PM-5PM, no sales are permitted during or after this time on Friday. Vendors must stop sales at 10 pm on Saturday 24 August 2019 and at 9 pm Sunday 25 August 2019. Tear down time is Sunday August 25 9PM-11PM and Monday August 26<sup>th</sup> 9AM-12PM.
- 8. Number of Booths per Vendor.** No vendor will have more than two booths.
- 9. Disposal of Oil.** Vendors shall properly dispose of oils and/or other chemical fluids. Dumping of oils into drainage pipes is not permitted.
- 10. Electricity.** Smaller equipment and basic lighting will be powered with no extra charge. Vendors with large chest freezers and refrigerators, electric grills, and other heavy equipment must bring a power generator or rent one from the Korean Harvest Festival staff. Charcoal barbeques or grills are not permitted. You are responsible for bringing your own extension cords and power bars.
- 11. Neatness.** Vendors will keep their items within a reasonable distance from their booth(s). Food vendors shall not obstruct foot traffic.
- 12. Damages.** Vendors shall be responsible for any damages they cause to Mel Lastman Square or Korean Harvest Festival property, including any rented equipment from the Korean Harvest Festival.
- 13. Garbage.** Garbage is to be disposed of in the 40 yard bin located on site. Please ensure garbage bags are closed securely and no sharp objects or skewers are disposed with organic material.
- 14. Noise and pollution.** Food vendors are not to use equipment that makes excessive noise or air pollution.
- 15. Security.** There will be security patrols provided overnight. However, vendors are responsible for the security of their own equipment and booths at all times, including overnight.
- 16. Alcohol.** No alcohol is permitted to be sold on Mel Lastman Square grounds.
- 17. Bottled Water.** No bottled water is permitted to be sold on Mel Lastman Square grounds.
- 18. Festival staff.** Festival staff will be available to answer questions and assist you during the festival. They will also be ensuring that the festival rules are being followed by everyone. Any vendor found to be non-compliant with one or more of the above rules their booth will be shut down by festival and Mel Lastman square staff. No refunds or compensation will be granted. If necessary a City of Toronto by-law officer will be called.
